# Introduction

The MonoFold collection brings you a versatile solution for temporary room division where structural support from above is not available. The system bears its weight directly on to its low-profile floor track, screw fixed to the floor.

The head guide track is merely there to secure the top guide pins fixed to alternate panels to prevent lateral movement and guide the panels along to deploy the wall and stack it back.

Unlike the MonoWall these panels are permanently hinged together allowing the MonoFold, as the name suggests, to fold backwards and forwards in a zig-zag fashion.

The lead panel acts as a pass door through the system, operated by a flush fit handle (Unless the system is End Fold with an even number of panels).

You have two layout options available. Single Wing, where the partition is stacked at one end and moved out the full width of the opening. The second is the Bi-Parting version; the stack is at either end and the partition meets in the middle. Please see our stacking arrangements in this brochure.

Furthermore the top guide pins can be located in three positions, depending on specification. In the top of the panel to facilitate the panels to stack either centrally, to one side or offset, details of which can be found further on.

Simple to operate, with an internal espagnolette locking mechanism, allowing for rapid and easy layout changes. The choice of finishes. sound reduction levels and track systems allow a complete bespoke package to be offered



# Specification

### Suspension & Support:

Bottom rolling support via a low profile floor track with a head guide track for the top roller in every other panel.

Up to Rw50dB.

### Operation:

Manual.

## Weight Range:

25 Kg to 50 Kg per m2.

## Maximum Height:

Up to 3,000 mm.

#### Maximum Panel Width:

Up to 900mm Panel Width - Centre Folding.
Up to 750mm Panel Width - End Folding/Eccentric Folding.

#### Panel Thickness:

Up to 100mm.

## Maximum Opening Width:

Varies according to system height and configuration.

#### Panel Finishes:

Include: Laminate, Veneer, Dry Wipe, Magnetic Dry Wipe, Vinyl, Paint, Pin Board, Fabric, or Primed for on-site decoration by others.

#### Panel Profiles:

Satin Anodised Aluminium (SAA) as standard, Electrostatic Powder Coating (EPC) also available in all RAL colours.


### Track Options:

Aluminium floor track track in Satin Anodised Aluminium (SAA)

Head Guide Track with matching Wall Jambs in Electrostatic Powder Coated (EPC) white. Also available with additional particle board pelmets.




# Stacking Arrangements




# MF1- Centre Fold Single Wing.

There is a top guide roller centrally mounted in the top of every other panel with a locking mechanism in the opposing panels. The system pulls out from one side to close off the opening, with the lead panel being an active pass door.




## MF3- Centre Fold Bi-Parting.

There is a top guide roller centrally mounted in the top of every other panel with a locking mechanism in the opposing panels. The system pulls out from both sides to close off the opening, with the lead panel from either side being an active and passive pass door respectively.



## MF2- End Fold Single Wing.

Similar to MF1 but the top guide roller is mounted to one edge in the top of every other panel with a locking mechanism in the opposing panels. The system pulls out from one side to close off the opening, with the lead panel being an active pass door.



## MF4- End Folding Bi-Parting

Similar to MF3 but the top guide roller is mounted to one edge in the top of every other panel with a locking mechanism in the opposing panels. The system pulls out from both sides to close off the opening, with the lead panel from either side being an active and passive pass door respectively.



With one active pass door




Max Glazed Panel Single Wing System

With one active pass door




Basic Panel Bi-Parting System

# Laminate Finishes

Our extensive range of panel finishes are the perfect compliment to your design and specification needs, to give your project that extra touch of quality, aesthetics and unrivalled performance.

All of our laminate finishes are laid onto a decorative paper film which is then impregnated with laminate resin, to give a high resistance to wear and abrasion from day-to-day use. This layer is then bonded to either, engineered particle board or medium density fibreboard (MDF) depending on specification.

We have three ranges for you to choose the best finish for your needs, the first being our standard range. This comrpises of the most popular solid colour and timber effect finishes which are available at no extra cost. Moving on we have our extended options where, for a slightly higher cost you have more solid and wood effect options to choose from. Then there is our bespoke range, where a particular finish has been specified. Details of both our extended and bespoke ranges are available upon request.

Not only can we supply a wide variety of colours and timber effects, we can also supply these with various textures to add an extra special tactile quality to your scheme.

Our laminate faced board supplier has been audited to meet the requirements of standard(s) FSCSTD-40-004 (Version 3.0) EN and FSC-STD-50-001 (Version 2.0) EN forFSC® Chain of Custody Certification Scope of certification: The Purchase, Sales and Distribution of Timber Products.

The laminate faced boards do not require any special care. If required the surfaces can be cleaned with soft, non-abrasive cloths or sponges. All commercially available mild surfactant-based agents which may not contain any abrasive components are suitable.

#### MonoPin


MonoPin is made from 100% recycled cellulose fibres, making it both ecologically sustainable and robust, creating the lowest life cycle cost option for wall displays and notice boards in a wide range of settings.

#### MonoFab

MonoFab is a plain weave panel fabric available in a wide selection of commercial colourways. One of our most popular vertical surface fabrics, this fabric is largely acoustically transparent and as such is ideal to be used as a decorative facing for sound absorbing boards.

#### MonoSorb

MonoSorb is specifically designed to reduce and control reverberated (echo) noise in building interiors. MonoSorb is manufactured from 100% polyester fibres and does not contain formaldehyde binders. MonoSorb polyester fibres support safer indoor air quality and will not become a potential airborne pollutant.







#### Works Carried Out

- ✓ Inspection of panels and adjustment
- ✓ Checking of top guide pins for damage/wear
- ✓ Lubrication of top guide pins
- ✓ Checking of head guide track for damage/wear
- ✓ Lubrication of internal cavity of head track
- ✓ Checking of top and bottom seals
- ✓ Securing top and bottom seals (where applicable)
- ✓ Checking of silicone acoustic seals
- ✓ Checking for visible signs of faults/damage and reporting on condition
- ✓ Cleaning of aluminium edge profiles
- ✓ Cleaning of face boards
- ✓ Full demonstration of wall
- ✓ Issue of completion certificate for your maintenance records

Where applicable, minor works which have been identified during the service will be done FOC such as:

- ✓ Re-securing of wall posts
- ✓ Changing of escutcheons

#### Extra Works

Where any major works have been identified this will be brought to your attention by our operatives at the time of service and a separate quotation will be forwarded for your consideration. Major works include (but not limited to):

- Guide Roller changes
- Internal damage to mechanisms
- Missing components/parts
